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
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Male pattern baldness

- Total testosterone = 7.3 / 10.3 nmol/l (within male reference range)
- LH = 24.6; FSH = 44.9 (post-menopausal values)
- Oestradiol = 225; SHBG = 33.6 (normal)

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Red flags

- The patient's age
- The rapid progression of hirsutism
- The virilization / degree of hirsutism
- The degree of androgen elevation
- A possible mass seen on sonography
- Sudden onset / sudden worsening





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
