Initiated when bolus approaches the esophagus


 (i) The UOS (Cricopharyngeus) has high resting tone; relaxes for 1 second → bolus enters the esophagus and propelled down by :

a- effect of gravity

b- peristalitic wave:

contraction above followed by relaxation below (vagal activity through the intrinsic nerve plexuses)

Bolus →tension receptors → afferent fibers (vagus) →vagal center (medulla) →efferent fibers (vagus)→muscle contraction → propels the bolus down (vago-vagal reflex)



ontrol of Swallowing :

Swallowing is co ordinated in the brain stem (medulla & pons) & the brain's frontal lobe. Acting through fivth, seventh, ninth, tenth & twelvth cranial nerves.

- The essential function of the esophagus is to transfer solids and liquids from the pharynx to the stomach.
- It occasionally functions to transfer gas (eructation) and gastric contents (vomiting) from stomach to mouth.
- It has no storage function (it empties and collapses after food pass to the stomach.
- It does not have any digestive or absorptive functions.
- It's only secretion is mucous → lubricants for the food bolus as it passes to the stomach.
