






## L5 Nerve Root

## INTERVERTEBRAL DISC HERNIATION

L5 nerve root involvement can cause
Trendelenburg Gait, due to posterolateral disc
herniation, because it affects the gluteus medius
and minimus muscles
(posterolateral disc herniation at L4 - L5 level
affecting the L5 nerve root).
